UNFUNDED CONSTRUCTION

Extend Mountain View from 4100 South to S.R. 201 (3 miles).

FUTURE PHASES

- Extend Mountain View Corridor from S.R. 201 to I-80
- Extend Mountain View Corridor from 16000 South to Lehi Main Street (5.7 miles)
- Intersections will be converted to freeway interchanges

- Additional lanes will be added
- Transit will be built
- Trails will be extended
