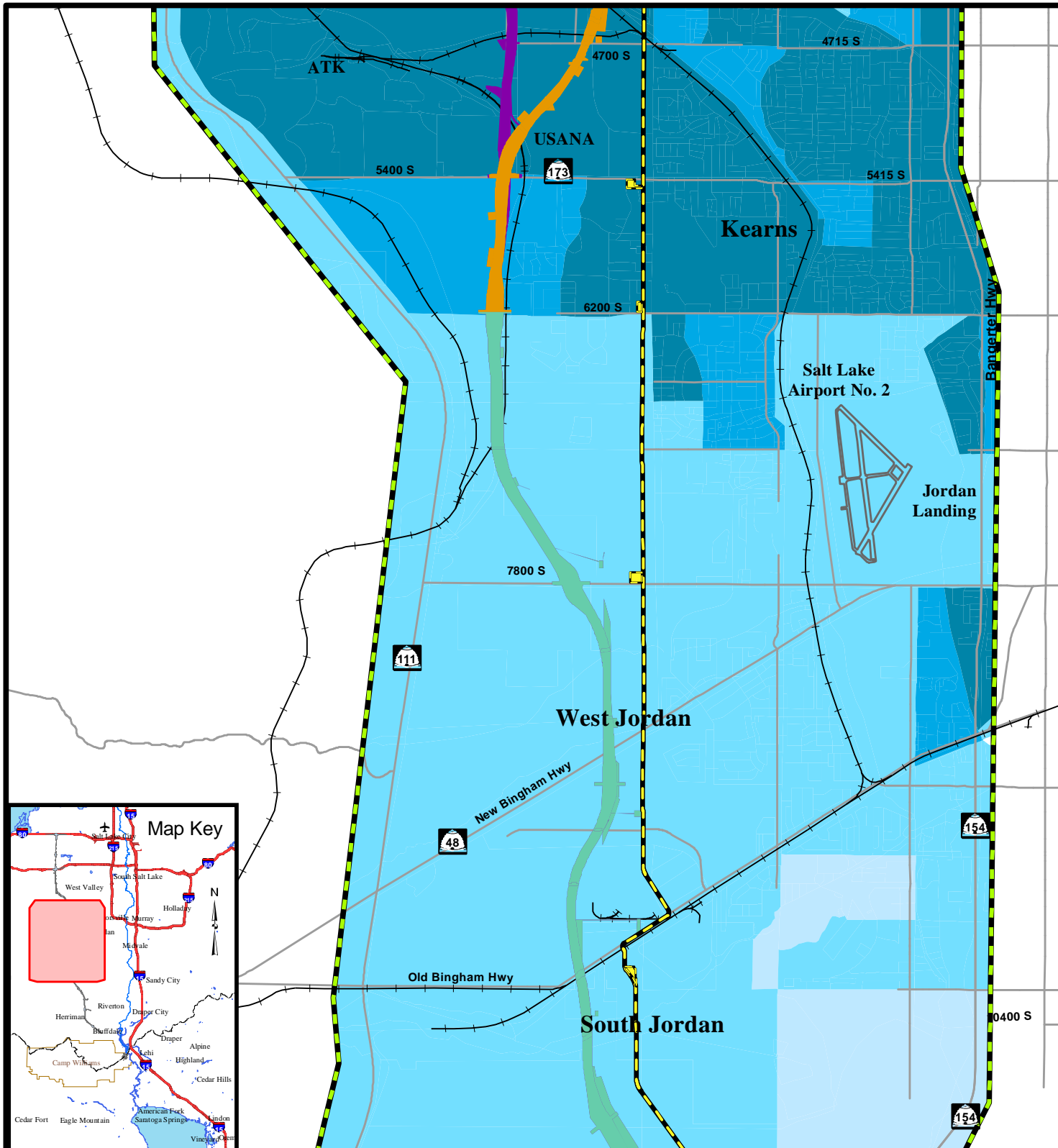

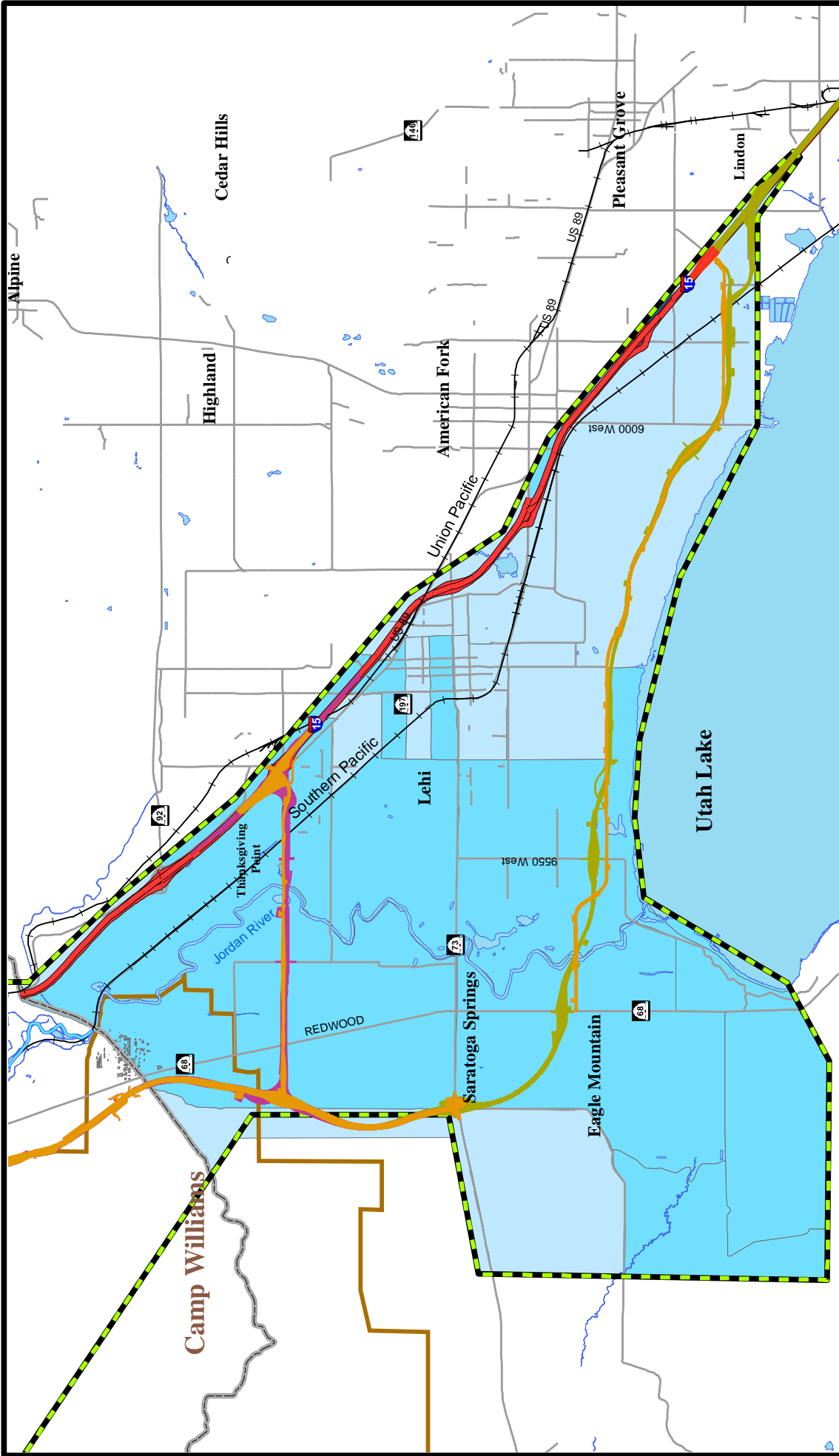

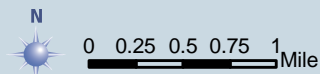
Distribution of Racial Minorities in the MVC Study Area - Utah County

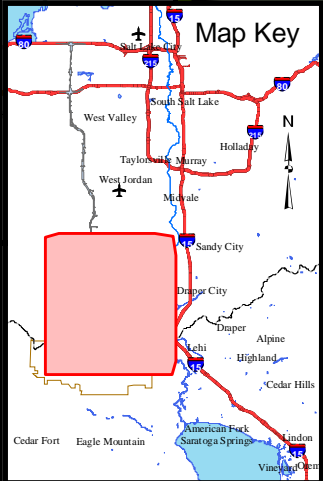

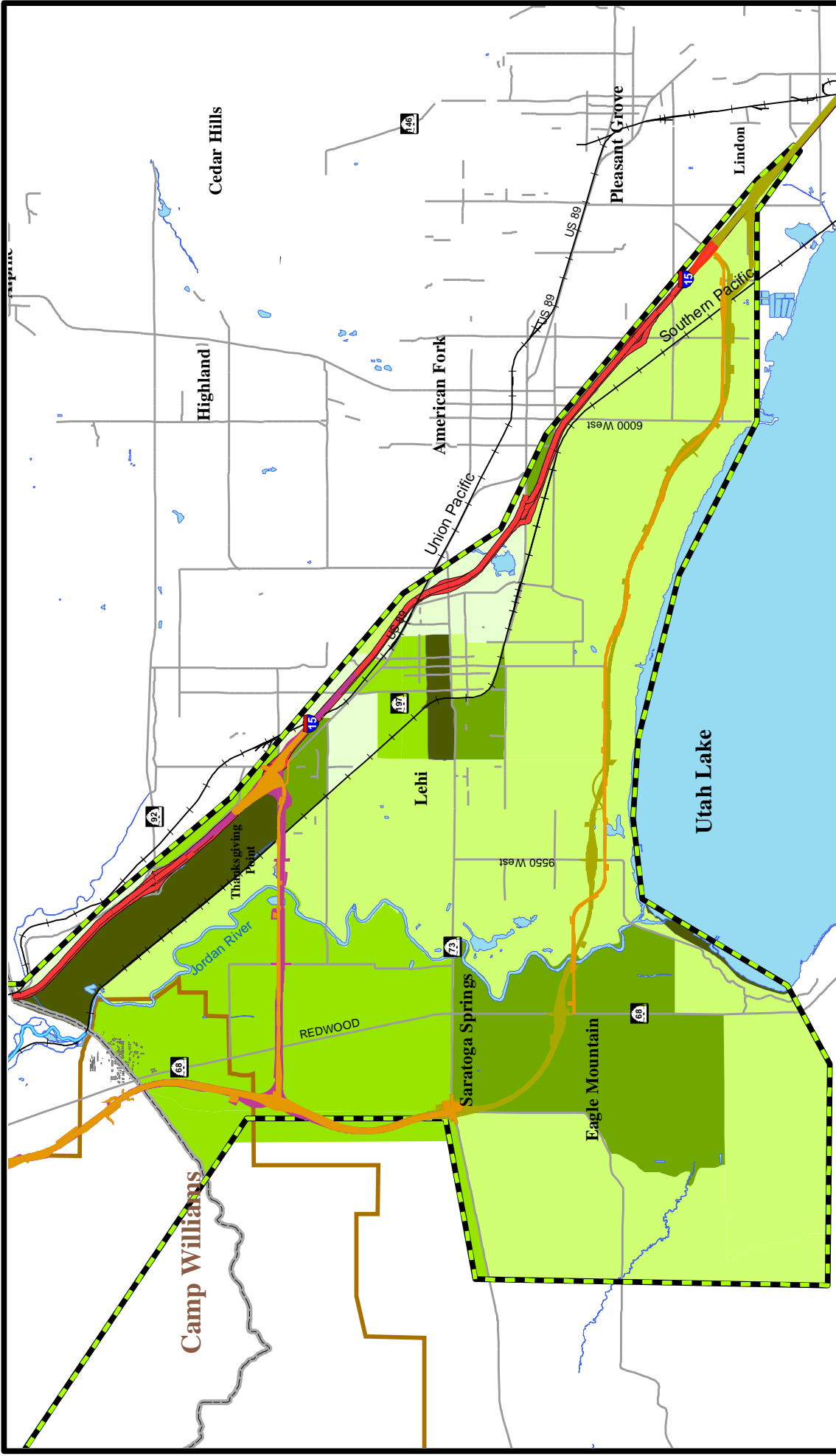

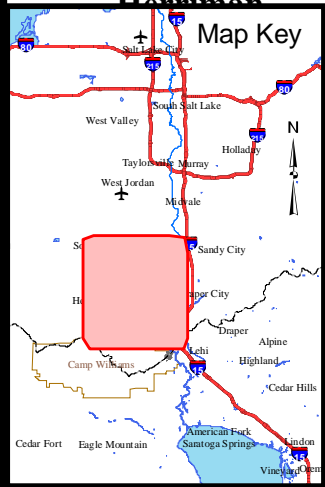
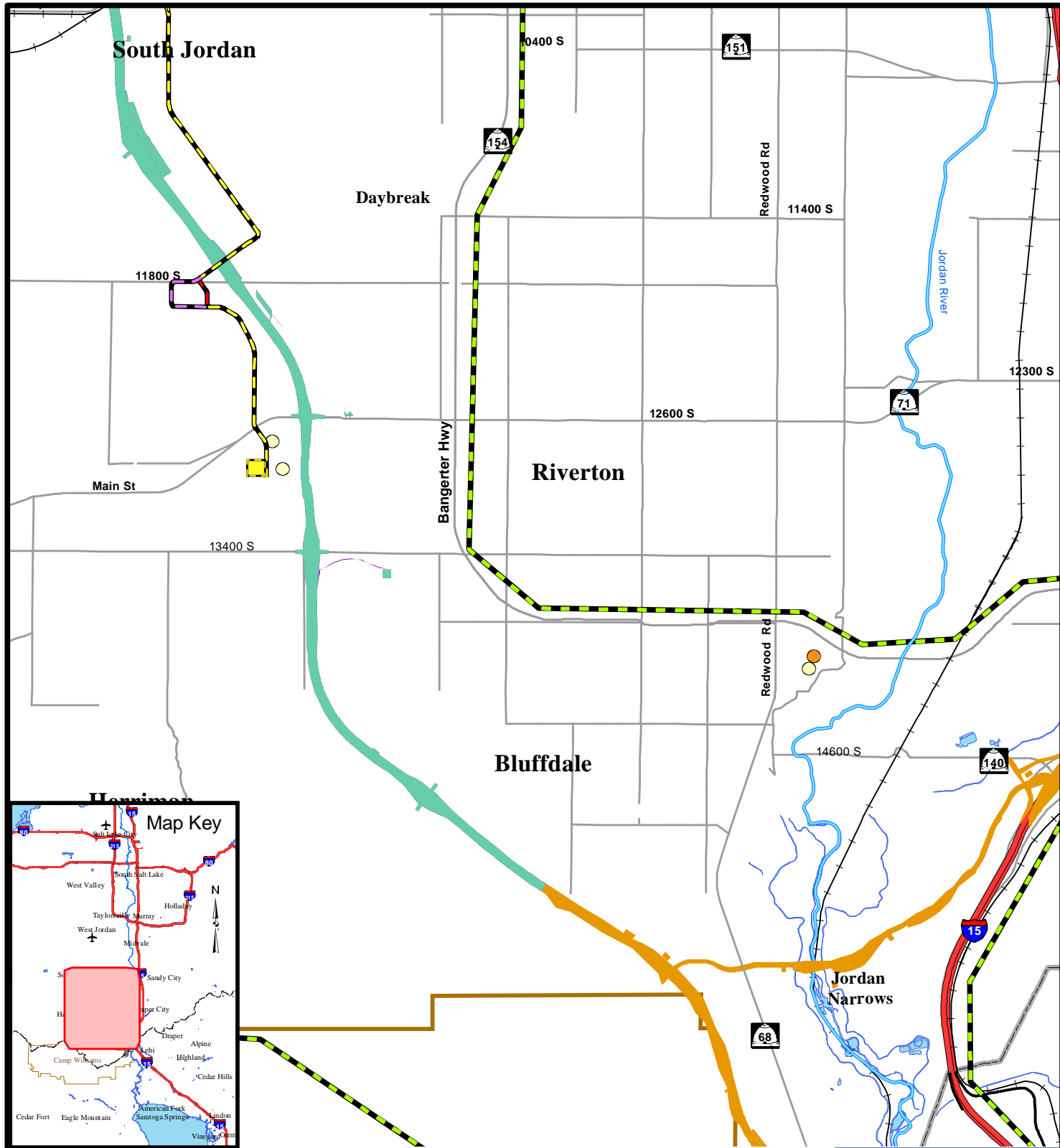



Environmental Justice Communities - 4700 South to 10400 South

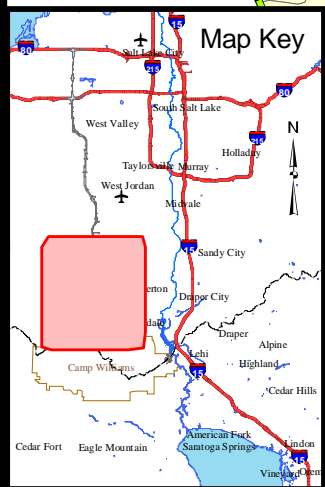

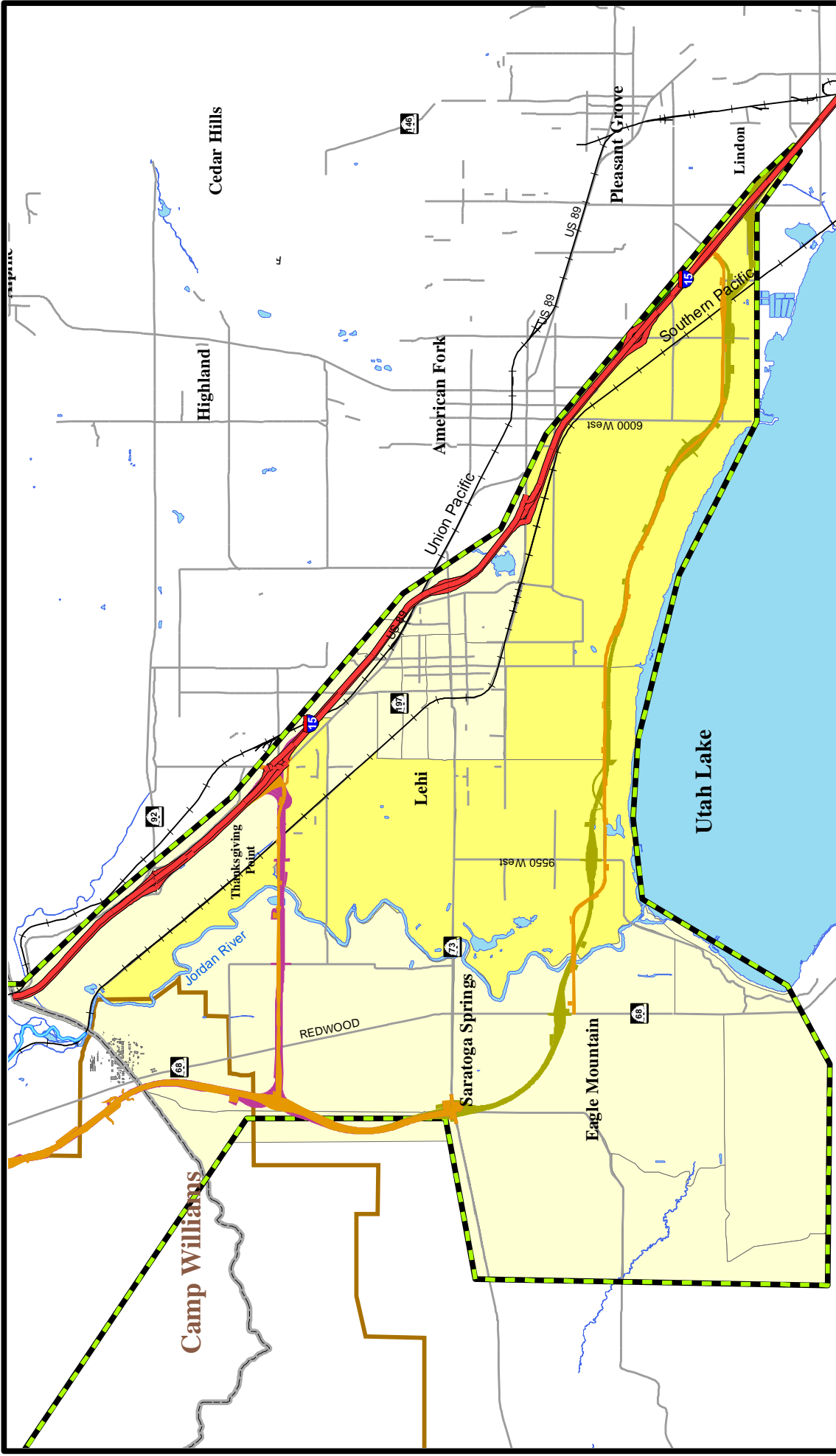
